WHO CAN RUN?

You are eligible if:

- ✓ Your company or service agency has been a NGAUS corporate member for at least one year prior to August 1, 2026, OR
- ✓ You represent a company with less than three years of membership but bring three or more years of National Guard experience (corporate or uniformed)
