Typical Milwaukee Weather

August 22-25

The average temperature for the entire month of August is around 72°F. The days may feel pleasantly warm, and the area may experience breezes. Wisconsin Avenue is known to create a wind tunnel effect through downtown Milwaukee.

While the humidity can make it feel warmer, it's generally not as intense as the southern states.

Overall: August in Milwaukee is generally warm and comfortable.

Harley-Davidson Motorcycle Ride
