

22-25 August

Some days might feel pleasantly warm, and the area may also experience breezes. The average temperature for the entire month of August is around 72°F.

While the humidity can make it feel warmer, it's generally not as intense as the southern states.

Overall: August in Milwaukee is generally warm and comfortable.


